

# No comment

Your task is to remove all comments from C/C++ program.

There are 2 types of comments:

- multi-line: `/* comment */`
- single-line: `// comment`

However, You have to remember about the character `\` which binds two consecutive lines. For example:

```
// this is a comment \  
that's still a comment
```

## Input

Program written in C/C++ with comments.

**Warning:** tests may contain characters of Ascii value greater than 127.

## Output

The same program but without comments.

**Warning:** "Exact judge" is used in this problem, so you should not ignore any whitespaces in the output.

## Example

**Input:**

```
// program which adds two numbers \  
sorry... three numbers  
  
#include<stdio.h>  
  
int main(void)  
{  
    int a, b, c;  
    /*  
     a - first number  
     b - second one  
     c - last but not least  
    */  
    scanf("%d %d %d",&a,&b,&c);  
    printf("%d\n",a+b+c);  
    return 0;  
}
```

**Output:**

```
#include<stdio.h>

int main(void)
{
    int a, b, c;

    scanf("%d %d %d",&a,&b,&c);
    printf("%d\n",a+b+c);
    return 0;
}
```
